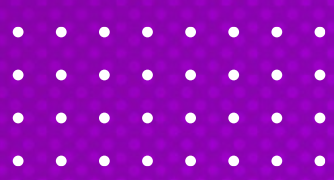

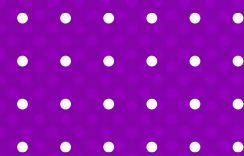
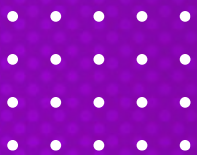
Over the years, our athletes have represented Surrey on some of the biggest stages, both nationally and internationally. We have competed at 12 World Championships and are proud to have been Worlds bid winners every year since 2012, a testament to the dedication, talent, and passion within our programme. Our teams have also performed at prestigious events including the London 2012 Olympics, T4 on the Beach, Reading Festival, Rugby 7s Finals, and numerous television appearances.

As we celebrate over 28 years of Surrey Starlets, we remain incredibly proud to be one of the longest-running cheerleading programmes in the UK. Each season continues to grow bigger and better, and this year promises to be one of our most exciting yet, with new opportunities, competitions, and developments for all athletes.

Our teams train across 2 locations, at the Surrey Starlets Purple and Pink Gym. The Purple Gym is located within Rosebery School in Epsom. The facility is fully equipped with a full sprung floor and specialised tumbling equipment, providing an excellent environment for athletes of all levels. Our Pink location at Wandle Valley Academy Carshalton provides a fully equipped gym for beginner and lower level teams. Both gyms are easily accessible via public transport, with direct links to London Victoria and Waterloo, and is conveniently located near the M25 with ample parking available.

At Surrey Starlets, we are more than just a cheerleading programme—we are a community. We pride ourselves on fostering a supportive, family-oriented environment where athletes can build confidence, develop lifelong friendships, and learn valuable life skills, all while competing at the highest level.





What route is best for me?

Recreational

Recreational cheer is great for beginners or athletes who wish for a less committed approach to cheerleading. Classes run weekly and athletes participate in the annual Purple Premiere showcase, but do not have the commitment of competitions. Novice comp teams is a more affordable route in to cheer and is great for beginners who wish to compete. Travelling to only 3 competitions per year, which are all local, and a more streamlined uniform, makes this a great option for those looking for a more affordable option. Athletes will need to attend Team Placements, and beginner athletes may be placed here. You can opt on your sign up form to only be considered for Novice Cheer

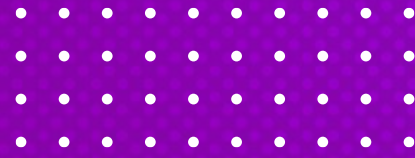
Allstar Competitive

Attending 4-6 competitions Nationally, Allstar teams are selected via age and ability, with teams ranging in level from 1 – 7! Athletes wishing to be considered for Allstar competitive teams will need to be fully committed to all training and competitive dates. Athletes will need to attend team placements to be selected for teams.

Each athlete wishing to be considered for the 2026-27 season will first need to sign up and book a place at Team Placements:

Cost: £15pp

Athletes are invited to our Team Placement evenings in groups dictated by age into the gym. Athletes will participate in a 'general class' and we will be evaluating athletes on their flexibility, strength, fitness, jumps, tumbling and stunting.

Athletes wishing to be considered to cross over on to another level / older age team can highlight this on their application form, and will attend the 2nd day of trials also.

Anyone in year 3+ wishing to be considered as a flyer for the new season will need to attend the flyer trial section, where you will be assessed on your flexibility, performance and choreography, twisting and somersault skills.

You will be contacted and informed of whether you have been offered a space on the Surrey Starlets Programme and which team at this stage.

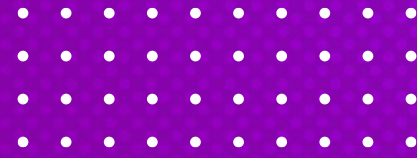

INFORMATION



Member Requirements

- All athletes primarily compete in teams in accordance to age rules from Sport Cheer England – when there are more than 1 team for 1 age group, athletes will compete in teams in accordance to ability.
- All athletes will compete for a full season at all competitions the teams attend.
- All athletes will compete for the season only as a Starlet with no other commitments to other cheerleading teams and programmes to avoid a conflict of interest.
- All athletes will attend all training sessions and competitions throughout the year and will only miss for extenuating circumstances (found in constitution)
- No athletes will take a holiday 3 weeks before a competition.
- All athletes will keep up to date with financial requirements
- All athletes will sign and abide by the Surrey Starlets Constitution and all given documentation

Choreography Days

This season, we are hosting a choreography day for most teams, to cover the main portion of choreography for the competitive routine. This day will be compulsory for all athletes on that team to attend. This leaves training sessions with much more time to work on skills and technique. Dates can be seen in the chart and are compulsory!

Tumble Classes

Tumble classes run every week and are included in your monthly fee! On notification of Team Placements, you will be allocated a tumble class which you can attend weekly! Whilst working on and learning new skills, athletes will gain their tumble reward badges!

Private Tumble Classes

We will be offering private coaching sessions for athletes who wish to sign up to them. These will be offered on a first come first served basis. Private sessions will be a maximum of 3 athletes working with a coach, specifically focused on progressions in tumbling and jumps, or flyer skills. Classes are 45mins for a 121, or 1hour for 2 or 3 athletes.

MONTHLY TRAINING FEE

-Monthly training fees cover the weekly sessions as listed on page 5 as well as tumble classes as listed on page 6.

-Training fees (for the whole year) are divided out equally per month. Monthly fees do not vary per month based on the amount of sessions. *(think gym memberships).*

- Training fees will be reduced for siblings by £15 per month which is taken off of the monthly fee = First sibling-full price, Second sibling £15 off, third sibling full price, fourth sibling £15 off etc... on classes **both siblings** participate in.

- Additional stunt training and workshops may be organised once or twice a year – all cheerleaders are expected to attend and pay the cost incurred

- Fees are due monthly and there is a £10 late fee (per month) when this is not kept to.

-Fees are due monthly on the 1st of the month. Fees paid after the 1st (or above noted date for comps) will incur a £10 late fee.

MEMBERSHIP PACK

The membership pack covers the costs of things such as insurance, equipment hire, music expenses, etc.

This membership includes an annual team t-shirt, a team jacket,. The team jacket will remain the same for next season, so returning athletes who already have this will have their membership price for that season reduced by £15

Athletes that are present and register on registration day, will receive a £15 discount on their membership amount.

World

CHAMPIONSHIPS



With Allium securing their 2027 Worlds bid, and following on from a most successful Worlds trip in 2026, where our World's teams scooped a 10th ranked title and a 4th in the Nations Cup, Allium and Astraera plan to be back to the sunshine state in April 2027 for our 13th World Championships!

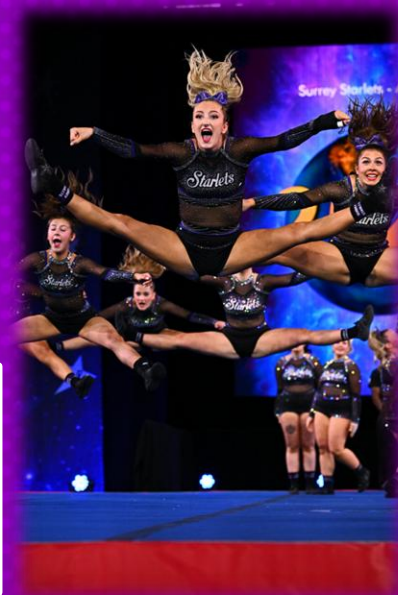
The trip will as always consist of exciting events, team building activities, showoffs and of course the competition.

The travel package covers every element of the trip, including flights, accommodation, transport, entry, training stash etc and costs approx. £2550 which covers every aspect of the trip, except food! Payments are taken in instalments throughout the year. This estimation is based on the last trip .

Due to the high level of this team, athletes aiming to compete with the A Team will be expected to have the highest level of commitment and ability.

All athletes under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

Athletes offered spaces on the Worlds team will need to pay their £350 deposit in July to secure their space on the team.

European TRAVEL

Having been privileged enough to win multiple bids to the Summit in the 2025-26 season, we are excited to have secured a bid again to head to Portugal to the European Summit 2027! We look forward to heading to Portugal, and/or another European competition in the new season!

The trip will as always consist of exciting events, team building activities, showoffs and of course the competition.

The travel package covers every element of the trip (except flights), accommodation, entry, training stash etc and costs approx. £800-£1000 per person (event and location dependent - this cost will be updated as we hear back in from our travel provider). Athlete's and parents will be responsible for their own flights booking and payments

Payments are taken in instalments throughout the year.

All athletes under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult
